In a unanimous vote (5-0) vote, the Clark CABMW supports all the changes made to Commission General Regulation 489, NAC 503.172, Shed Antler Season, NAC 501.200 with the following recommendations:

- 1) NDOW should consider adding a two-tier violation approach. We currently have a penalty for a person with a hunting license, but need to add a strong penalty for a person shed collecting that does not have a hunting license.**
- 2) It seems to the CABMW that the \$999 misdemeanor penalty for a commercial collection violation is not a deterrent. Several examples of willing violations by commercial collectors in the Mount Grafton wilderness were presented to the Clark CABMW from members of the public. We recommend a stiffer penalty for commercial collection violations.**
