- 1* **Commission Regulation 21-13, 2021, 2022 Season Bag Limits and Special Regulations for Migratory Game Birds.** The Board will consider recommendations to the Commission as they will consider recommendations for season, bag limits and special regulations for migratory game birds for the 2021-2022 season and adopt regulations consistent with proposed regulations framework for the 2021-2022 hunting seasons on certain migratory game birds established by the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service. The Commission Regulation will also consider rules regulating public hunting on Wildlife Management Areas and designated state lands.
- 2* **Commission General Regulation 498, NAC 503,147 Ms. Cathy Smith – Petition Bear Hounds.** The board will submit recommendation to the Commission in regards to Ms. Smith who has submitted a petition to change language in NAC 503.147 to withdraw dogs from bear hunts. The Commission accepted the petition during the November 6, 2020 Commission meeting.
