- 1) **Commission Regulation 23-15, Fishing Seasons and Regulations for January 1, 2024, through December 31, 2025.**

In a unanimous vote (5-0) vote, the Clark CABMW supports Commission Regulation 23-15, Fishing Seasons and Regulations for January 1, 2024, through December 31, 2025 as presented with the following comment.

The Clark CABMW recommends that in the fishing regulation that anglers be reminded that they are prohibited from transplanting any aquatic species into any Nevada waterway. Only authorized personnel can do such transplanting.

- 2) **Winecup Gamble Land Exchange Clark CABMW position letter**

As there are little or no details about this land transfer, the Clark CABMW in a unanimous vote (5-0) vote believes that this land exchange is not in the best interest of Nevada's sportsmen, sportswomen and the general public. In addition, the Clark CAB will develop a

letter to send to BLM and our State/Federal Congressional representatives detailing our opposition the Winecup/Gamble Land Exchange, supported by the Clark County public.

3) Commission Policy 23 – Predation Management, Third Reading.

In a split vote (3-2) vote, the Clark CABMW approves Commission Policy 23 – Predation Management, as presented. In addition, the Clark CAB “STRONGLY” recommends that a redline/strikeout version should always be made available when changes or consolidations are made between public readings.

The dissenting opinions felt the wording of the *“Project Budget”* should be clarified to make it clear that Pittman/Robinson federal dollars could only be used for nonlethal projects.

In a unanimous vote (5-0) vote, the Clark CABMW supports Commission General Regulation 510, FCFS Exchange to Obtain a Tag, LCB File No. R038-23 as presented, with the following recommendations:

- 1) **In NAC 504.135 subsection-4 “toxic” should be replaced with “lead” as we know of no other shot in commercial shells that is toxic per the US Fish and Wildlife Service..**

- 2) **In the newly inserted Pole Canyon Cooperative Wildlife Management Area section bullets 2 (ADA electric or battery assisted vehicles) and 3 (service animals need to be allowed) need to have ADA caveats inserted for compliance**
