  - b. NBWC 11.\* Commission Policy 23 – Predation Management – FOR POSSIBLE ACTION Third Reading – Administrative Procedures, Regulations and Policy -The Commission will review Commission Policy 23 and may make any necessary changes and may decide to repeal, revise, or adopt the policy.

C. \* Commission General Regulation 509, License and Vessel Product Refunds, LCB File No. R037-23 – Data and Technology Services - The Commission will consider and may take action to approve amending Nevada Administrative Code (NAC) 502 and 488 to allow the Department authority to provide refunds on licenses and vessel products.

Commission General Regulation 510 is currently a temporary regulation that is set to expire on November 1, 2023.
